


1. A ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION:

- i. Under graduate students between the ages of 17 and 22 may contest elections.
- ii. For Post Graduate Students the maximum age limit to contest and election shall be 25 years.
- iii. Age shall be counted on the first day of nomination.
- iv. The candidate must be a regular full time student of the College/ University, the course duration being at least one year.
- v. He/ She must be a bona fide member of the students' union.
- vi. He/ She must not be a student of part time course or open distance learning mode.
- vii. He/ She must be a student admitted to a Degree course or Diploma or Certificate course of a period not less than one year at the time of filing nomination.
- viii. He/ She must have a minimum of 75% attendance.
- ix. He/ she must not have appeared at the final examination or been sent up for the final examination.
- x. He/ She must not have any academic arrears in his/her respective programme.
- xi. He/ She must not have any previous criminal record i.e. should not have been tried for or connected to any criminal offence or misdemeanour.

2. DISABILITY/ DISQUALIFICATION FOR STUDENT MEMBERS AS CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION:

No student shall be entitled for election as a candidate if:

- i. He/ she is not a member of the students' union.
- ii. He/ she has completed 7 years in the University.
- iii. He/ she is past the prescribed age as in 9A(i)-(iv) above in Chapter III.
- iv. He/ she has been held guilty of and punished for use of unfair means at an examination held by any college or any University or who has been rusticated by any college or any University or who has been expelled from the hostel of the college or the University on disciplinary grounds.
- v. He/ she has been sent up for or appeared in the final University examination.

- vi. No elected office bearers shall be entitled to hold the same post of office bearer twice in the General Council.
- vii. No elected office bearer of the executive council shall contest for the same post in the executive council for the third time.
- viii. A member will cease to be a member if he/ she becomes of unsound mind.
- ix. A member will cease to be a member if he/ she is charge-sheeted/ convicted of any criminal offence on record anywhere in India or abroad.
- x. Violation of Code of Conduct disqualifies the Students from the candidature.

3. DISASSOCIATION OF STUDENT ELECTIONS AND STUDENT REPRESENTATION FROM POLITICAL PARTIES:

- i. During the period of the elections, no person, who is not a student on the rolls of the college/university, shall be permitted to take part in the election process in any capacity.
- ii. Any person, candidate, or member of the student organization, violating this rule shall be subject to disciplinary proceedings, in addition to the candidature as the case may be, being revoked.

4. The following criteria of students are not eligible to vote:

- i. Final year sent up students of under graduate and post graduate.
- ii. Students lodge in jail.

5. ELECTION RELATED EXPENDITURE AND FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY:

- i. The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate shall be Rs. 5,000/- (Rs. Five thousand) only.
- ii. Each candidate shall, within two weeks of the declaration of the result, submit complete and audited account of the election related expenditure to the college/ University authorities. The college/ University shall publish such audited accounts within two days of the submission of such accounts, through a suitable medium so that any member of the student body may freely examine the same.
- iii. The election of the candidate will be nullified in the event of any noncompliance or in the event of any excessive expenditure.
- iv. With the view to preventing the inflow of funds from political parties into the student election process, the candidates are



specially barred from utilizing funds from any other sources than voluntary contributions from the student body.

6. THE OFFICE BEARERS OF THE STUDENTS' UNION:
